

Engg services export crosses Rs 10k cr

■ **NEW DELHI:** The engineering services export of the country, excluding IT and telecom, has crossed Rs 10,000 crore in the financial year 2007-08, said a review by IT magazine Dataquest. According to the review report, engineering services export of the country grew by 25.6% in 2007-08 and touched Rs 10,110 crore. This figure excluded key elements such as software product engineering, semiconductor design and other high tech/telecom engineering, said Dataquest. The review added that aerospace and automotive industries lead the outsourcing business of engineering design from the country. It further said 93% of the total export was from top 15 firms, led by TCS with Rs 832 crore. It was followed by HCL and Satyam with Rs 762 crore and Rs 610 crore.
