THE CLIENT

HCL successfully implemented a procure-to-pay project at one of the Europe's largest local authorities, employing around 60,000 staff with a €3.5bn annual budget. THE PROBLEM

- The client consisted of a highly complex organisation, which introduced a vast array of strategic and operational challenges. It was essential for the client to reduce their overall operating costs, whilst increasing their service quality and effectiveness
- Large invoice volumes, paper storage requirements, and little automation of invoice receipt required

large resource overhead and spiralling costs to manage.

- Frequent and high volumes of payment queries received from suppliers
- Large numbers of non-PO invoices required manual approval by budget holders
- Culture resistant to change
