

OVERVIEW

HCL OneTest UI enables testers to take automation all the way from mainframe terminals with 3270 interfaces, through .Net and Java based thick client applications and ERP systems such as SAP and Oracle, right up to HTML5 based responsive web applications built on modern frameworks like Angular, React and Vue.js in the latest versions of the world's top browsers. Validation of business processes is achieved through simple yet powerful scripting tools which empower complex test assertions, created with just a couple of clicks. Integration into DevOps pipelines (Jenkins, UrbanCode, etc) allows users to embed automated testing in the development process and increase the quality of deliveries.
