Definitions

Capitalized terms not otherwise defined in this ALA document are defined in the governing agreement.

Term	Definition
SAU	Simultaneously Attached Users means the number of users attached to the telecom network for services including but not limited to subscribers, devices (IoT), corporate users, and such.
TPS	Transaction per Second – One transaction corresponds to one message received by the platform from the network to be processed by eIUM. Usually, one transaction corresponds to one request from a network element and one response going back to the network element.
XDR	Usage detail record, where x refers to Call (CDR), Event (EDR), Session, et cetera. CDR extension for data and other telecom services.
E-LTU and E-Media	Means products which are electronically delivered only, and as such any reference to FOB Destination or delivery methods that are stated on your purchase order other than electronic shall be null and void with respect to these E-LTU or E-Media products.
LTU	Means License To Use.
Use	Means to install, store, load, execute, and display one copy of the software.
Use Case	Means a specific function or set of related functions as defined by HCLTech or a third-party specification.
Operating System	Means software that controls the operation of a device such as a PC or mobile device and directs the processing of programs.
Consumption	Right to use the software for a limited period of time with variable capacity, reported in arrears and with potential renewal upon term expiration.
Subscription	Right to use the software for a limited period of time, with up-front defined fixed capacity and with potential renewal upon term expiration.

Software specific license terms

Software products with software specific license terms are described below.

HCLTech enhanced Interactive Unified Mediation (eIUM)

The HCLTech eIUM software provides telecom service platform for mediation, charging, entitlement, event routing, and similar services. HCLTech eIUM can be licensed on perpetual, consumption, or subscription-based models. The HCLTech eIUM software is licensed (perpetual license) based on:

- Peak number of SAU
- Peak number of TPS sent to platform for processing
- Peak number of XDR (e.g., CDRs for voice calls are XDR for data usage) generated by the platform daily
- Optional use cases (e.g., Diameter Routing)

The supported Operating Systems and databases are separate functions. Each is licensed separately. The HCLTech eIUM software requires a separate license to a third-party database and a separate license to an in-memory database to operate. These licenses are available through HCLTech.

The HCLTech eIUM perpetual offering:

- License is calculated based on the parameters described above (SAU, TPS, XDR, use cases)
- Peak numbers of SAU, TPS, and XDR are determined based on 1 month audit period

The HCLTech eIUM consumption offering:

- Usage is calculated based on the total number of Use Cases enabled and the peak numbers of either SAU or TPS or XDR during the agreed upon term, which can be renewed and extended as needed.
- Invoicing will occur quarterly in arrears based on actual usage. If actual usage falls below minimum usage, the pre-determined minimum usage fee will be charged.

The HCLTech eIUM subscription offering:

- Usage is calculated based on the total number of Use Cases enabled and the peak numbers of either SAU or TPS or XDR during term
- If subscription maximum usage is exceeded, customer must purchase additional subscription capacity
- The subscription license is a one-year term license that can be renewed prior to expiry
- Invoicing occurs at the beginning of the subscription

Additional license terms

Term
